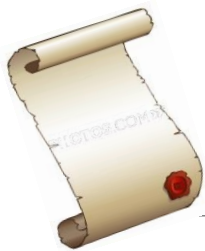

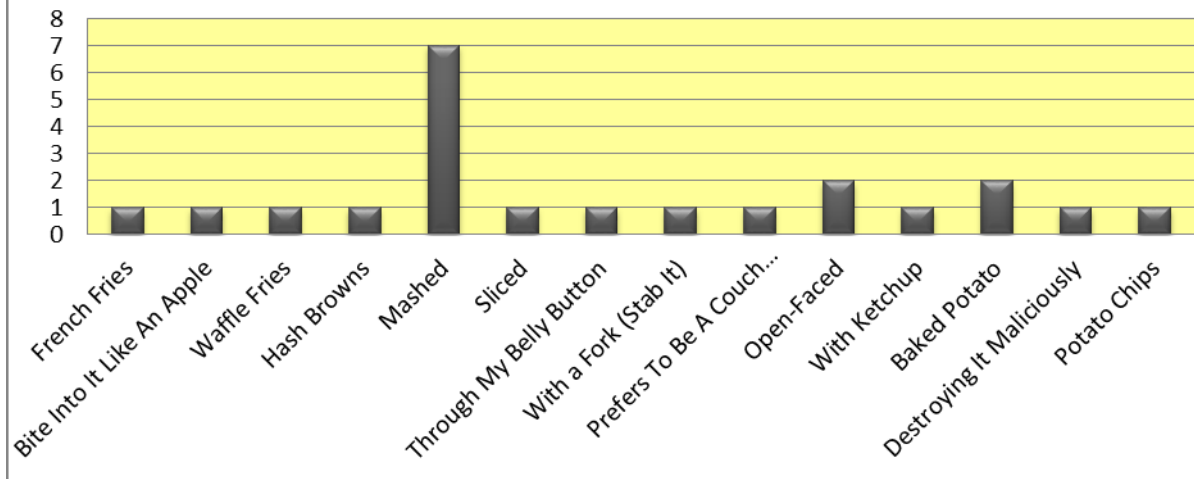

Chocolate Marshmallow Dreidels

Ingredients:

- 12 Chocolate Kisses
- 8 oz. Melted Semisweet Chocolate
- 12 Marshmallows
- 12 Thin Pretzel Sticks
- 2 oz. Melted White Chocolate

Directions:

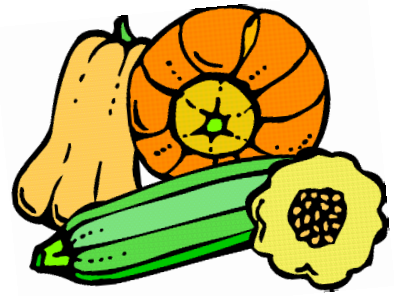
1. Dip the bottom of the chocolate kiss melted in semisweet chocolate. Press onto marshmallow; transfer to a parchment-lined baking sheet. Repeat to make 12 dreidels. Refrigerate for 10 minutes.
2. Cut a small slit in bottom of each marshmallow; insert 1 this pretzel stick. Dip dreidels in chocolate, and return to baking sheet. Refrigerate until set; about 15 minutes.
3. Fill a re-sealable plastic bag with melted white chocolate; cut a tiny opening in the corner, and pipe Hebrew letters onto 3 sides of each dreidel. Refrigerate at least 5 minutes or up to 8 hours before serving.

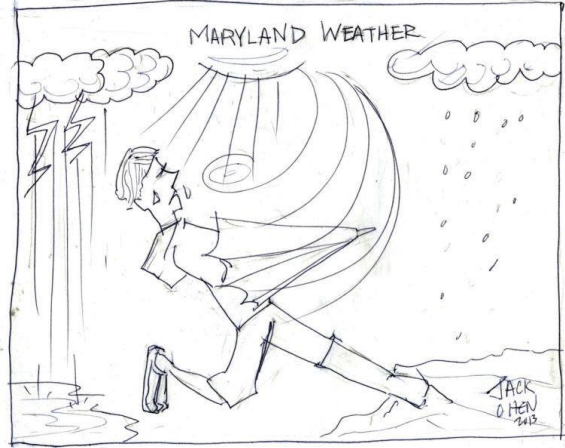
